

## QUALIFICATIONS

To qualify for the Medicare services, the patient must be under the care of a physician or podiatrist, be home bound and require intermittent skilled care. This may include observation, instruction, or hands-on care.

### Accessing Los Angeles Home Health Care Group

LAHHCG works on a referral basis. Though referrals typically originate with the physician, they may also originate from any local hospital, doctor's office, board and care or skilled nursing facility and also, from the patient's family, other interested person or agencies. Between 24 and 48 hours after LAHHCG representative will be alerted to the patient's needs, the patient will be seen, evaluated and care will begin. Under certain circumstances, special immediate care can be rendered the same day.
